



A Three-Week Summer Seminar

ON WAR

In ancient times war was often seen as defending one's home and nation against attacks, and warriors were seen as those who put themselves in harm's way to protect family and freedom. In modern times war is often considered the opposite of good government. What is the truth about war, and more importantly what do statesmen need to know about war? If statesmen are ignorant of war, they can't truly lead—even in peace time. In this intense three-week course we will study ancient and modern war, strategy and tactics, the relation of war with good government, and the basics that every citizen, leader and statesmen should know about war. We will learn the path of the warrior, and why it is vital for all citizens to understand this path. We will look at the development of technology and its impact on war, and at the probable future of war in the 21st Century. We will read the greatest classics of war, including Sun Tzu, Clausewitz, Jomini, Frederick, Napoleon, Mahan, and major world scriptural teachings on war and warfare. This class is a must for anyone who wants to really understand history, government and statesmanship. Earn 6-9 credits* in this intense course on war, warfare and the path of the warrior.
